ABOUT THE BRUSHES

Thanks for buying Tattoo Art Brushes! The pack is compatible with Procreate 4.1 and above with Apple Pencil.

Illustrator and Affinity Designer versions are also available at artifexforge.com.

The pack contains the following brushes:

Tattoo Art Brush Liners

Tattoo Art Brush Shaders

Tattoo Art Brushes - Pressure sensitive version

I prefer using the non-pressure sensitive version of the stipple brushes but I've included the pressure sensitive version for those who need it.

Please read on to find out how to load and use the brushes...

UNZIPPING THE BRUSHES

Before you can load the brushes you must unzip the brush files. Follow these steps:

ON A COMPUTER (MAC):

1. Double-click the '.zip' file.
2. Locate the file or folder inside and move it to the location of your choice.

ON A COMPUTER (PC):

1. Right-click on the '.zip' file.
2. Click 'EXTRACT ALL' and follow the instructions.

IF YOU DON'T OWN A COMPUTER:

Depending on your OS you may need a third party plug in to decompress a zip file on Ipad.

LOADING THE BRUSHES INTO PROCREATE

Once you've unzipped the brush file you can install it by following these steps:

1. Transfer the '.brushset' file/s from your computer to your Ipad. Using a cloud service such as 'Dropbox'.
2. On your Ipad Open the Dropbox app and locate the folder into which you saved the '.brushset' file.
3. Tap the '.brushset' file and click the '...' icon.
4. Click 'Export', 'Open In...' and then tap 'Copy to Procreate'.
5. Open Procreate. Your new brush set will appear at the top of the brush library.

Please note: if you have MacOS 10.11 or newer, you can use 'Airdrop' to transfer and install the brushes in one go.

IMPORTANT: Don't use Procreate's brush panel import function - this is designed for single brushes only and won't work with .brushset files.

DRAWING WITH THE BRUSHES

To draw with the brushes simply select a brush from the 'Brush Library' and draw.

To adjust the size of the brush stroke move the slider as shown below:

Move the slider to
adjust the brush
stroke size



Choose the brush color by clicking in the circle on the right-hand, top of the screen, as circled below. Do this before you draw.

HOW TO USE THE BRUSHES TO BUILD AN IMAGE

This is how I use the brushes and it's a good place to start. As you use the pack you may develop your own methodology.



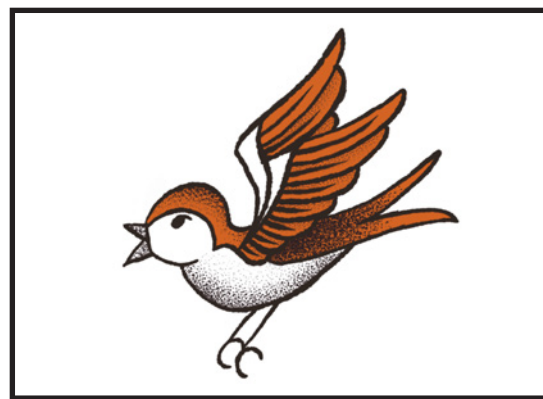
Start by drawing a rough image. This could be created in Procreate or a hand drawn, scanned image.



On a new layer trace your rough using one of the liner brushes. Increase and decrease the pressure while drawing to create uneven, blobbed ink.



Create another layer beneath your outline layer and use this to draw your stippling shading.



If you want to include blocks of solid color, add another layer below your stippling layer and create it there. Finally, knock out your rough layer.
